The CCI Eating Disorders Programme will be holding a **2-part session for loved ones who are supporting a person with an eating disorder**.

The sessions are based on the book *Skills-based learning for caring for a loved one with an eating disorder - the New Maudsley Method* by Janet Treasure, Grainne Smith & Anna Crane (2007).

The first session will include:

- an introduction to eating disorders
- the effect of starvation on the brain
- the impact of eating disorders
- what loved ones can do to help
- resources
 (local treatment options; internet; books)

The second session will include:

- why loved ones should be involved
- reducing stress of loved ones
- styles of communication
- principles of good communication
- modelling good communication
- problem solving
